





### The Kinastowski's Principle











At Office Samurai, employees are eligible for funding for postgraduate studies under the following conditions:

- Eligibility: Employees must have received approval from their direct supervisor and the company president for
  reimbursement of costs related to postgraduate studies that align with the company's activities or personal/professional
  development within Office Samurai. Additionally, employees must have been with the company for more than 6
  months.
- 2. **Funding Amount**: The reimbursement covers 50% of the total tuition fees, up to a maximum of 4,000 PLN.
- 3. **Company Initiated Studies**: If the company decides to send an employee for postgraduate studies, the percentage of funding is determined individually.
- 4. Exclusions: The funding does not cover costs related to exams, educational materials, travel, accommodation, etc.
- 5. Application Process:
  - Employees must coordinate all formalities related to the funding with the HR department.
  - This includes determining the required documents to be signed between Office Samurai and the educational institution, as well as agreeing on the documentation confirming payment (e.g., invoice, payment confirmation).
- 6. **Repayment Obligation**: If an employee withdraws from or does not complete the postgraduate studies for which they received funding, they are obligated to repay the entire amount of the reimbursement. The repayment terms will be





#### **Retrieval-Augmented Generation (RAG)**



RAG improves Al-generated content by combining two steps:

- first, it retrieves relevant information from databases or documents;
- then, it uses this information to create more accurate and detailed responses.
